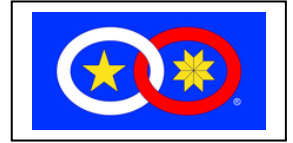

**Summer Research Technician 2025**

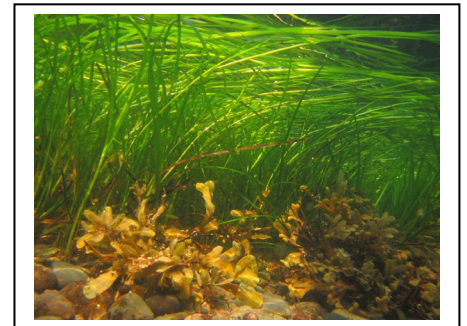
**DESCRIPTION**

The Summer Research Technician (SRT) 2025 will be responsible for assisting the OERS Biologist in Residence at the Comeauville Marine Institute (CMI). The SRT will be part of a team that may consist of other scientists, technicians, students, and interested individuals all working together. In addition to having strong attention to detail, the SRT will demonstrate excellent communication skills. Out in the field, the SRT will work with our staff, students, and volunteers to collect data/samples during a variety of ecological scientific projects (eelgrass bed studies, marine animal strandings, plastic analysis, etc). The SRT at the CMI will work with our staff to process samples, perform tests, and record results. All training will be provided onsite. Excellent opportunity to gain experience in environmental research such as new graduates from high school, college, and university.



Broad Responsibilities:

- 1) Assist with field work and aquarium research work.
- 2) Work alongside scientists to assist with research work.
- 3) Assist with aquarium work involving green crabs, eelgrass, and fish sample taking.
- 4) Assist with research in marine biology looking at pollutants in various marine species.



Broad Requirements:

- 1) Have excellent English reading/writing comprehension skills to understand work-related documents.
- 2) Be part of a team and as such will require strong listening, speaking, writing skills, and interpersonal skills (English).
- 3) It will often be necessary for some of the work to be done in the field such as on a beach, or in various bodies of water (bay, river), or under harsh weather conditions (intense wind, deep cold, hot sun, etc). The SRT will be expected to participate in all or any types of weather conditions.
- 4) Be able to carry 40 lbs.
- 5) Have a positive attitude and love learning.
